Pick-up days and delivery days are on Mondays and Thursdays. 3 meals are sent with individuals on Mondays (for Mon, Tues, and Wed) and 3 meals are sent with individuals on Thursdays (for Thurs, Fri, and Sat). Although they do not currently provide meals to adults, depending on the need, they may consider this in the future. There will need to be additional internal discussions and planning for providing adult meals.
